ICE TIME POLICY

ADOPTED MAY 01, 2014

It is the policy of the Iron Range Hockey Association (IRHA) that all registered players are to practice and play games within their respective USA Hockey Level and with their respective teams. Goal tenders are allowed to skate up or down one level if the coach of the upper/lower level needs an extra goalie for his/her practices. If there is more than one goalie available at the level the coach must rotate between all goalies.

Specifically sanctioned events are an exception only if written and applied for as such by the Board of Directors of the IRHA.

Non USA Hockey Registered players and coaches are not permitted on IRHA scheduled ice.

For the last two weeks of scheduled ice time, coaches may ask the 2nd year players who are advancing to the next level to practice with their team. Example, 2nd year Bantams asked by Midget coach to attend last 3 practices of the year.

Any IRHA player who skates on non-approved ice time will be pulled from their next scheduled ice time practice for the 1st violation. The 2nd violation will result in the player losing at least one week of ice time until the IRHA Board reviews the incident.

Any violations can be reported to that levels board liaison or a board member.
